CALL FOR QUALIFICATIONS

RESEARCH GRANTS FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES AT UPAEP

One of the priorities of the Vice Rector's Office for Research at the UPAEP is to **promote the active participation** of young people in the development of research projects, directed by a researcher of **recognized experience**, while pursuing their studies in one of the current degree programs.

ADDRESSED TO:

High school students who have a minimum grade point average of 9.0 up to the semester immediately prior to the submission of the application.

Scholarships may be awarded for 50% to 80% of the tuition cost.

PROCESS

STEP 1 Application Form.

Fill out and submit the research grant application using the following form.

The application must be accompanied by the following documents:

- **LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION** from the director of your institution.
- **LETTER OF EXPLANATION OF REASONS** for studying the career to which you are applying.
- **CONSTANCE** with grades and cumulative average up to fifth semester.
- Official **EVIDENCE** of participation in formal research and outreach activities or events during high school.

The research grants committee will acknowledge receipt of applications.

STEP 2 Research protocol.

The applicant to obtain the scholarship will present in person or online (depending on the place of residence) to the Research Scholarship Committee an original research protocol



according to the lines of generation and application of knowledge of the degree program of interest within the stipulated time. The research protocol must include the following points:

- 1. Project title.
- 2. General objective of the project.
- 3. Background (if any).
- 4. Statement of the problem and/or area of opportunity.
- 5. Justification.
- 6. Scope.
- 7. Main activities to be performed.
- 8. Expected results (including publications in peer-reviewed and indexed journals, patents, plant breeders' rights, among others).
- 9. The research protocol may include tables, graphs and photographs.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. The applicant will present in person or virtually in no more than ten minutes his/her research protocol to the Research Grants Committee.
- 2. The Research Grants Committee, at the end of each applicant's presentation, will evaluate the relevance of the project and rate it using a rubric
- 3. The Research Fellowships Committee Coordinator will collect the rubric evaluations, collate and present the results for each candidate.
- 4. The scholarship office will notify all applicants of the results; in the case of acceptance, will also inform the scholarship percentage assigned.
- Places may be declared vacant at the discretion of the Fellowship Committee.



• In order for the scholarship to be valid, the registration fee, which is not included in the scholarship, must have been paid.

TO MAINTAIN THE RESEARCH GRANT

During their studies at the University, scholarship recipients must continue with the research activities of this same project or another related project authorized by the Basic and Applied Research Department, with the purpose of presenting it in subsequent research events at the local, national or international level, selected exclusively by the UPAEP.

Scholarship recipients must pass all subjects taken, with a minimum average of 8.5 in each period.

Students accept that, upon a change of career, the benefit of the scholarship is lost.

Research scholarships will be subject to the General Scholarship Regulations of the UPAEP.

OF THE RESEARCH GRANTS COMMITTEE

Group of academics, researchers and administrators whose objective is to manage in a transparent and equitable manner the awarding of research grants to applicants who meet the requirements and have proposals that contribute to the strengthening of academic programs in accordance with the UPAEP identity.

MEMBERS

- One representative from each deanery
- A representative from the Promotion area.
- Research Grants Program Coordinator
- Three researchers assigned to the program to be studied or related.
