RESEARCH STUDY GRANTS OF POSTGRADUATE STUDIES AT UPAEP

One of the priorities of the Vice Rector's Office for Research at UPAEP is to promote basic and applied research among young people and adults who are interested in developing research products while pursuing graduate studies in specialties, master's degrees and/or doctorates.

OBJECTIVE

To encourage, develop, promote and put into practice serious and rigorous research projects through the participation and collaboration of students and academics who make contributions in the different disciplines in accordance with the priorities and values of our Institution.

ADDRESSED TO:

Applicants who wish to be part of the UPAEP graduate student community and students who are currently enrolled in graduate academic programs.

REQUIREMENTS



STEP 1

Filling out the application form:

Complete and submit the research grant application through the following link: <https://forms.gle/ork2x7ShwUWbQXC56> (please copy and paste into your browser). The Research Grants Committee will acknowledge receipt of applications.

- The application must be accompanied by the applicant's CV, including evidence of scientific publications, if any.



- The application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from an academic validating the applicant's research skills.

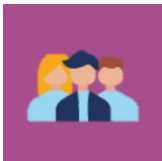


STEP 2

Research protocol:

The applicant to obtain the scholarship will present in person or online (depending on the place of residence) to the Research Scholarship Committee a research protocol according to the lines of generation and application of knowledge of the graduate program of interest within the stipulated time. The research protocol must include the following points:

1. Project title.
2. General objective of the project.
3. Background (if any).
4. Statement of the problem and/or area of opportunity.
5. Justification.
6. Scope.
7. Main activities to be performed.
8. Expected results (including publications in peer-reviewed and indexed journals, patents, plant breeders' rights, among others).
9. Resources required for the research project.
10. The research protocol may include tables, graphs and photographs.



STEP 3

Dedicate the necessary time to the research project as agreed with the academic responsible for the project.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

1. The applicant will present in person or virtually in no more than ten minutes his/her research protocol to the Research Grants Committee.
2. The Research Grants Committee, at the end of each applicant's presentation, will evaluate the relevance of the project and rate it using a rubric.
3. The Research Fellowships Committee Coordinator will collect the rubric evaluations, collate and present the results for each candidate.
4. The scholarship office will notify all applicants of the results; in the case of acceptance, the scholarship percentage assigned will also be announced.

TO MAINTAIN THE RESEARCH GRANT

Pass the courses taken with a minimum average of 8.5 in each period.



1. Meet the objectives set forth in the research project submitted to the Research Grants Committee.
2. The student should devote the necessary time to the research project to meet the objectives.
3. Research scholarships will be subject to the General Scholarship Regulations of the UPAEP.





4. The scholarships to be granted may have a percentage ranging from 60% to 85% of tuition, not applicable to registration or expenses for obtaining the degree.



5. In order to validate the scholarship, the registration fee must be paid in advance.

6. In exceptional and justified cases of change of graduate studies, the Research Grants Committee may authorize a new research project.
